## Who wins?

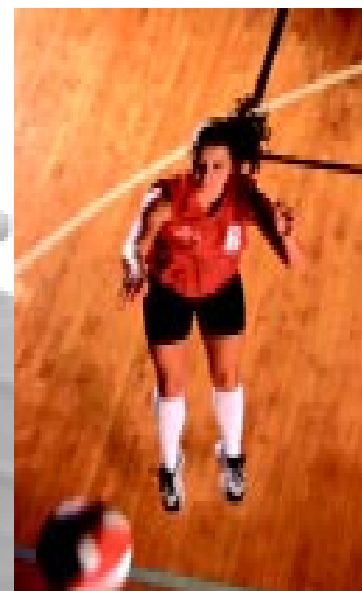

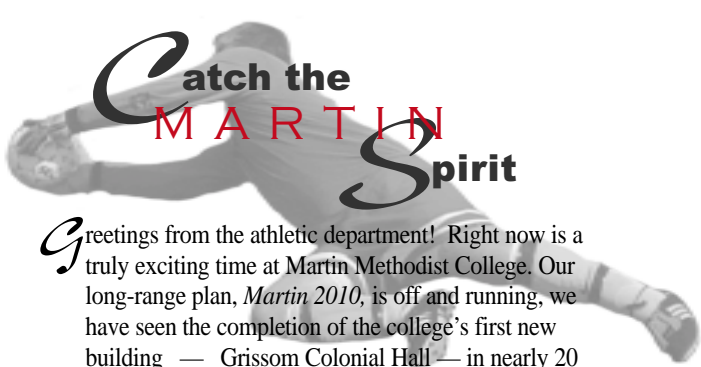

Greetings from the athletic department! Right now is a truly exciting time at Martin Methodist College. Our long-range plan, *Martin 2010*, is off and running, we have seen the completion of the college's first new building — Grissom Colonial Hall — in nearly 20 years, and we have yet another record enrollment as the 2002-03 academic year gets under way.

This is also an exciting time for the athletic department. We are coming off one of the best years in our short time as a four-year institution. Our athletic teams had an average conference finish of third, and several made appearances in NAIA regional or national tournaments. We had 44 student-athletes named as a TranSouth Athletic Conference Scholar Athlete, and nearly one-third of our student-athletes held a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

Not only did we get the job done on the field of competition and in the classroom, we also got the job done in the community. Our student-athletes participated in 19 community service projects — such as volunteering in elementary school and senior health care programs, hosting free sports clinics, and visiting children's hospitals. In doing so, we have done our best to reach out to the community.

This year is proving to be even more exciting! We're geared up to compete for TranSouth championships; we're thrilled about the naming of a new Martin Methodist mascot, which will take place during Homecoming on Nov. 16; and we have the nation's first sponsor of an NAIA Champions of Character program in Rackley Systems, a firm located right here in Pulaski.

We want to do all we can to ensure that our athletes have every opportunity to succeed in competition, in the classroom, and in the community. This is where you can help!
